DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Welcome to driver education! It is expected that students will take every advantage of what is offered in the course.

Learning to maneuver the vehicle is only part of safe driving. This driver education program will provide the information to make safer and risk-reducing decisions in an ever-changing environment, where alcohol, drugs, peer pressure, and the unused seat belt are contributing factors to a higher risk of accident, injuries, and death to the 16 to 25 year-old age group.

You, the future driver, have the greatest responsibility in this course. Not only does this course prepare you for getting your license, but our hope is that some part of it will make you a safer driver with fewer accidents and fewer violations than the average driver. In order to do this, we need your mature desire to learn in the next 46 hours of training, allocated as follows:

- Thirty (30) hours of classroom instruction - where serious and long lasting skills, knowledge, and the development of appropriate attitude towards driving are developed.
- Ten (10) hours of behind-the-wheel instruction to reinforce the material learned in class.
- Six (6) hours of observation time in the Driver Education vehicle.

This driver's education program is for you, if you are willing to take responsibility for your actions.

The following is a guide to help us work through this program together responsibly.

1. You must be responsible and ready to do your part.
2. You will be dropped from the program without refund if:
 - a. You are absent or miss ANY portion of classroom time for any reason determined not to be good cause. Good cause is described as an illness, injury, death in the family or family emergency.
 - b. Absences for good cause exceeds four hours.
 - c. You are ten minutes late for driving times for any reason four times.
 - d. Your behavior creates a problem before, during, or after class.
You are responsible for all material, assignments, and projects, etc.
No late work will be accepted.
3. You are expected to come prepared for class:
 - a. To have read and studied materials.
 - b. To bring textbook, notebook, paper, pen, and a pencil
 - c. To be ready and willing to learn

If you are not prepared for class, you will be asked to leave. [This will result in being dropped from the program.](#)

4. Eating food, candy, chewing gum, drinking tonic or soda in the classroom will be grounds for dismissal from the class.
5. Proper care of the textbook loaned to you and other property and materials is expected. A fine for damage will be levied at the discretion of the instructor and the school administration.
6. In order to pass the course: a 60% average will be necessary, along with a display of proper driving skills, and **a minimum of 40 hours of practice driving outside of class, due the last day of class.**
7. An in-car lesson will be terminated at the discretion of the instructor any time a question of safety exists. Only the reasonable suspicion of alcohol, or other drug influence, is necessary to terminate the lesson. Non-cooperation or poor preparation for any lesson may also lead to termination.
8. The non-refundable course fee is due with the application.
9. **Students who are late (more than 15 minutes) for driving time will be liable to pay a fee to cover the cost of the instructor's time (\$70.00/per hour).** Repeat offenders will be dropped from the program.

Schedule: These are the Proposed dates for Driver Education classes during 2010-2011 School Year. These are all the classes that will be offered during the school year. Please plan ahead, so that you may take the class that would best fit into your schedule.

Class dates may be cancelled and rescheduled due to the weather, or any other unforeseen situations. The final Schedule will be mailed to you when we receive your payment **in full**, and a **Photocopy of your Birth Certificate**. Confirmations will be mailed out on a first come first served basis.

The Cost of this course is \$655.00. Qualifying residents of SAU #4, 48, or 68 will pay \$505.00.
